

consider and decide the representation of the petitioner in a time bound manner.

3. It is averred that the petitioner has completed tenure of two winters and three summers at a station, which falls in tribal area of District Chamba, H.P. As per the provisions of 'Comprehensive Guiding Principles-2013', petitioner has become entitled to be transferred and posted at a place of his choice.

4. The prayer being innocuous is not opposed. 5. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner, Annexure P-1, within a period of three weeks from the date of the production of the copy of this order, strictly, in terms of the 'Comprehensive Guiding Principles-2013'.
